

Massachusetts State Council Annual State Recognition Awards

1. Nurse Educator Award

This award honors an emergency nurse who has made significant contributions to the education of colleagues, nursing students, EMS personnel, patients and families.

- a. Educational expertise in emergency nursing or emergency care
- b. Performance beyond job expectations in developing programs and/or teaching tools
- c. Emergency nursing expertise through publications, speaking at educational meetings and/or curriculum development
- d. Active participation in the development and/or implementation of an emergency care program
- e. ENA membership
- f. 2 letters of support

2. Nurse Practice Award

This award honors an emergency nurse who exemplifies outstanding nursing practice as demonstrated through clinical skills, nursing care and compassion

- a. Demonstrates emergency nursing knowledge through performance of consistent high-level care and compassion to patients and significant others
- b. Quality care as evidenced through implementation of the ENA Standards of Emergency Nursing Practice
- c. Consistently demonstrates compassion through patient care
- d. Participation in nursing programs, committees, or projects contributing to emergency care
- e. ENA membership
- f. 2 letters of support

3. Nurse Manager Award

This award honors an emergency nurse manager who consistently demonstrates excellence in the profession of emergency nursing, leadership skills, a high level of professional behavior and has made significant contributions in the area of emergency nursing management.

- a. Demonstrates innovative program development
- b. Encourages professional development through role modeling, mentoring and leadership
- c. Demonstrates commitment by serving as a resource and consultant on emergency care issues
- d. Recognized by staff and peers as an effective manager and nurse leader
- e. ENA membership
- f. 2 letters of support

4. Behind the Scenes Award

This awards recognizes an individual who consistently supports Massachusetts ENA without the expectation of reward.

- a. Has given significant contributions to MENA through donation of time, energy and effort
- b. Assists in development and implementation of MENA projects and programs
- c. Donates significant time without the expectation of being rewarded for this commitment
- d. ENA membership not required
- e. 2 letters of support
